### 1. Call To Order And Roll Call

There was consensus that these 2 were replicated correctly.

Ms. Bell reported that there were still 40-50 voters in line in Lake Wales.

The next 4 were reviewed to determine voter intent. Chair Gibson was designated to mark the replicated ballots accordingly.

The first was reviewed regarding the charter amendment with different markings. Voter intent was determined against.

The second was reviewed regarding the charter amendment. There was a small mark in the "for" circle. Voter intent was determined against.

The third was reviewed for the Mayors race. It was determined for Jack Hilligoss.

The fourth was reviewed for the Mayors race. It was determined for Jack Hilligoss.

The first set of results for Election Day voters at precinct 526 were reviewed.

3. Accept Unofficial Results

The full unofficial results were reviewed. In the Mayor's race Jack Hilligoss won with 60.96% of the vote. Curtis Gibson received 39.04%. For the Charter Amendment 75.37% voted For the change. 24.63% voted against.
