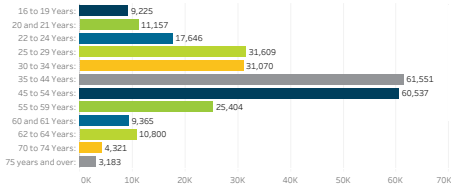
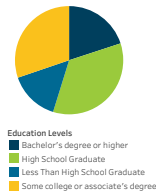

Labor Force by Education

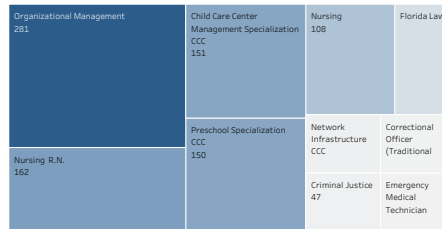
