


TEEN D&D CLUB


FRIDAYS: 4:30-6:30

- **No supplies needed:** We provide all dice, character sheets, and game materials for every session.

- **Character-building help:** A staff member can assist you in creating a character. If you'd like help, please arrive 15 minutes early.



- **Timely pickup required:** The program ends at 6:30 PM. Please have transportation arranged at that time. Two staff members must remain with attendees until everyone has been picked up.

- **Pickup location:** Teens should be picked up at the south parking lot, located on the opposite side of the front entrance.

- **Parent attendance policy:** Teen D&D Club is for teens only. Parents may not attend the program or remain in the room during teen events. 




TEEN ART CLUB

SATURDAYS 1:00-2:30

AGES 14-18



- **No supplies required:** You're welcome to bring your own sketchbooks, tablets, or drawing tools, but no materials are needed to participate.
- **A creative social space:** Teen Art Club is a relaxed maker-space style hangout, not a formal class. We'll occasionally offer supplies for optional craft projects, but you're always free to work on your own creations.
- **Pickup and closing time:** The program ends at 2:30 PM, and the library closes at 3:00 PM on Saturdays. Teens may stay until closing, but please have transportation arranged by 3:00 PM. Two staff members must remain with attendees under 18 until they are picked up.
- **Pickup location after closing:** If a parent arrives after the library has closed, pickup will take place in the front parking lot.
- **Parent attendance policy:** Teen Art Club is for teens only. Parents may not attend or remain in the room during teen events. Parents with questions or concerns may call (863) 678-4004, email jobarron@lakewalesfl.gov, or use those methods to schedule an in-person appointment.



UNATTENDED CHILD POICY



- **Closing Time:** Minors who are **13** or older are allowed to be unaccompanied while at the library. However, at closing, minors who **remain on the library property** at closing time will have **two** staff members wait with them until they are picked up. Below are our regular closing times.

- **Unaccompanied Computer Use:** Even unattended teens may not use the reference computers without the supervision of an adult.



- **Behavior Procedure.** Patrons who are old enough to visit the library independently are expected to follow the Patron Behavior Policy. If a teen does not meet these expectations, they may be asked to leave library property for a designated period of time.

1st Instance: 48 hours

2nd Instance: 1 Week

3rd Instance: 2 Weeks

4th Instance: Permanent Ban

TEEN VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Who is eligible?



Teens who are **15 or older** may volunteer at the Youth Services Department of the library. This volunteer work is valid for academic purposes, but we *cannot* accomodate *court-required* community service hours.

When Can I Volunteer?



The library is open Monday-Saturday. We usually assign teens one day a week, where they come in and volunteer for 1-3 hours.

What would I be doing?



Volunteer work most frequently consists of shelving returned books, cleaning duties, and organizing supplies for crafts. You may also occasionally assist during library programs.

How do I sign up?



1. You fill out a teen volunteer information form in person at the Youth Services or online (Scan the QR Code on the left.)
2. Our Teen Services Librarian will contact you to discuss scheduling.
3. You will be given a date and time to come in for your orientation.
