



Lake Wales Municipal Airport Campground – RULES AND REGULATIONS

Camping

- You must camp only in the lot number specifically assigned.
- All vehicles, RVs, and trailers must be parked on your campsite. Driving or parking off road is not permitted.
- Quiet hours are between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Please be considerate of others.
- A child is any person under the age of 18. You are responsible for the actions and safety of your children, and other children who are under your supervision. No child may be left in the campground without a responsible adult supervising him/her.

Sanitation

- All garbage and litter must either be deposited in containers provided, or taken with you when you leave.
- Littering is prohibited in every area of the campground.

Campfires

- Fires are prohibited at all times.

Vehicle Operation

- Drivers must obey all traffic signs and operate their vehicles in accordance with posted regulations.
- Use of vehicles within campgrounds and other recreation areas is limited to entering or exiting those areas.

Pets and Animals

- All pets must be attended, leashed, and cleaned up after in all areas of the campground.

Fireworks

- Use of fireworks or other explosives within campgrounds is prohibited.

All campers and their visitors are required to obey all municipal ordinances, resolutions and other laws, all county regulations and laws, all state laws, and all federal laws.

The City of Lake Wales reserves the right to revoke your camping privileges should you and your children and/or visitors fail to comply with any of these Rules. By utilizing the campground and its services you hereby consent to the same.
